# **School Coach Services**

## Introduction

For the benefit of families with children in Primary 4 and upwards, we operate morning/afternoon services as follows:

Please note routes are subject to change.

Prices vary according to the stop used. For regular bookings they range from £1.17 to £6.47. Ad hoc bookings are charged at a slightly higher price. Exact prices and timetables can be found later in this booklet. All prices shown are for a single trip.

Families are welcome to make a regular booking for any combination of morning and afternoon journeys. In the event of oversubscription, priority will be given to those pupils who use the service most often.

## Live tracking

The driver will register each pupil boarding and exiting the coach. The tracking system works on a live feed and will enable parents to track the route of their particular coach via the Vectare site on their mobile phone. Should a coach be running late, a notification will be sent to parents advising them of the delay.

## **Booking procedure**

Parents are invited to book from Monday, 11 August 2025.

All coach bookings should be made via the online booking system <https://esms.vectare.co.uk>. For convenience, parents can access the site via a link on Firefly or 'my esms'. Please register your child to the service prior to making a booking.

Parents will be able to view their current booking on the Vectare system. Bookings can be altered or cancelled as required.

Rebates for unused journeys will be provided only where a child has been asked to take part in a school activity. Please contact the Transport Coordinator to arrange this.

All charges for the school coach service are paid through Extras Accounts.

Pupils in year groups P6, P7 and S3 will automatically receive a reduction in transport charges for term 3 to take account of absence from school for Camp and Carbisdale.

We ask that parents control their own bookings, especially during exam/study leave.

## **JS Bus Club**

Junior School pupils who use the afternoon coaches are supervised in the SMC Dining Hall until the vehicles depart at 16:20. The supervisors ensure that all the Bus Club children board the correct coach safely. The price for this is included in the charge for the coach journey.

Pupils are encouraged to do homework but may also talk quietly with friends.

Good behaviour is essential at Bus Club. Repeated bad behaviour will result in exclusion from the Club, which would jeopardise the child's place on the coach.

A register is updated daily to show which Junior School pupils are expected at Bus Club; this is based on existing bookings. Pupils sign-in when they arrive at the Dining Hall, and the registers are checked before allowing the coaches to depart.

Children who do not appear at Bus Club when expected can cause the coaches to be delayed while attempts are made to contact the parents.

***It is essential that you contact the Transport Coordinator to let us know if your P4-P7 child is being collected or is not using the afternoon coach service for any other reason.***

## FAQs

### ***Do the coaches run every day?***

Coach services begin on the first whole day of the session (Wednesday 20 August 2025) and run every day when Junior and/or Senior pupils are in school.

The only exception is the last day of the session (Wednesday 24 June 2026) when neither morning nor afternoon services will run.

### ***Are pupils supervised before the departure of the afternoon coaches?***

Junior School pupils are supervised at JS Bus Club. It is the responsibility of Senior School pupils to get themselves on to the homeward coaches.

### ***Where does my child get off the coach?***

Please note that the coach drivers cannot take responsibility for ensuring children get off the coach at the correct stop. We would therefore suggest that an older sibling or friend accompanies a younger child until he or she is confident and sure of the stop to be used. Any child found to be on the coach at the end of its route will be taken back to the depot and kept until collected by a member of the family. **Please ensure your child knows which coach they are booked on to and the name of the stop they are alighting at.**

### ***What happens if my child misses the coach home?***

If your child misses the coach at the end of the school day, they should immediately go to the closest school office or find any member of staff and tell them what has happened. If we know your child has missed the coach home, we will try to contact you as soon as possible. In such an event your child would wait in their relevant Reception area until collected by you. Parents should ensure their children know what to do if the coach does not arrive on time, not turn up or if parents are delayed when meeting them from the bus in the afternoon.

### ***What do I do if the coach is late in the morning?***

You will be able to monitor the exact location of the coach by visiting the 'My Account' section of the Vectare website and then navigating to 'Live Tracking'. Alternatively, please contact AAA Coaches, Eve Coaches or ESMS on 0131 311 1160. Parents should ensure their children know what to do if the coach does not arrive on time or does not turn up.

### ***Who monitors behaviour?***

It is a condition of travelling on the school coach that the 'Rules for Pupils' are observed at all times. Any pupil who acts in an inappropriate manner will not be allowed to use the coach service. In particular, all pupils **must** wear the seat belts provided during the journey.

Please note that school coaches are not supervised, and the schools cannot accept responsibility for children until they reach their classrooms.

Concerns about behaviour should be passed to the Transport Coordinator, Sixth Form coach prefect or class/form teacher.

### ***What happens to lost property?***

**Please contact AAA Coaches or Eve Coaches directly if an item is left on a coach.**

All the drivers regularly check their coaches and items can usually be found quickly and handed into Junior School Reception. From there, items are passed to the Lost Property team.

Alternatively, you can use the 'Contact us' form on Vectare and select the 'Lost property' option.

### ***Can my child take a friend home?***

Any family wishing to use the coaches to take a friend (or overseas exchange partner) home should contact the Transport Coordinator to check availability. The relevant charge will be added to the Extras Account.

***How does my child travel back from Games?***

Most Games for P5 to P7 pupils and Senior boys take place off-site. Junior School girls go to Ravelston at MES. Junior/Senior boys travel to Inverleith, East Fettes Avenue or (for some Senior boys) the Spartan's football ground at Ainslie Park.

For those who require it, transport is provided to return pupils to SMC (and Haymarket on certain days). For Junior pupils, the Games register taken each week will be used to ensure sufficient seats are available on the return Games coaches. There is no charge for this service.

***Are refunds offered for unused journeys?***

Individual regular journeys may be 'cancelled' without penalty prior to 9am on the day before the date of travel. Thereafter parents will be charged but should still update the Vectare booking system if their child will not be travelling on any journey where they are booked; please then mark the journey as 'not travelling.' Ad Hoc journeys cannot be cancelled and will be charged.

***What are the adverse weather arrangements?***

Snow, high wind, and serious road accidents can impact the coach service but rarely cause it to be cancelled; it is essential that you keep both Vectare and ESMS updated with your mobile telephone number so that you can be contacted at short notice. In the event of disruption to either morning or afternoon services, a notification will be sent to parents from the Vectare Service Delivery Centre.

***Am I able to track the school coach?***

You are able to track the location of the coach in the 'My account' section of the Vectare website and then navigating to 'Live Tracking'. To receive notifications when your child boards the coach please go to My account -> Update account details and select the relevant check box.

***Will the driver wait if I am late?***

Our coaches serve a large number of passengers, so we are unable to wait beyond the scheduled departure time. If we wait for pupils who are running late, the coach will arrive late at school, and this is unfair on those pupils who are at the bus stop on time. All pupils are asked to arrive at their bus stop at least 5 minutes before their scheduled departure time to ensure that they do not miss the coach.

***What age can pupils start using the school coaches?***

Pupils can start using the school coach service from Primary 4 upwards. We prefer younger pupils, if possible, to be accompanied by older siblings and would prefer that all Junior School pupils are met off the bus by their parent or guardian.

***What happens if the Forth Bridges close?***

Both Dalgety Bay and Dunfermline coaches use the Forth Road Bridge. High winds can cause the Forth Road Bridge to be shut to high-sided vehicles although the single-deck coaches on our Dunfermline and Dalgety Bay routes are seldom affected.

Where alerted to the possibility, the school and AAA monitor the status on

In the event of the FRB being closed, our coaches would then use the Queensferry Crossing.

In the very unlikely event of both bridges being closed, the following procedure will be followed:

**Morning:** If both bridges close early in the morning, a notification will be sent informing parents of the arrangements that have been put in place.

**Afternoon:** If both bridges are closed, the Dunfermline and Dalgety Bay coaches will remain at/return to school. Parents will be contacted to make arrangements for their children to be collected (Junior School pupils will be supervised in the dining hall until 4:20 pm and thereafter in JS Reception, Queensferry Terrace. If the FRB is closed and the Queensferry Crossing is open to cars only, the coaches may travel to the car park at Ferrymuir Gait, where children can be collected. Details of contingency arrangements will be sent to parents through the Vectare system.

***Is it possible to cancel a regular travel booking in its entirety?***

It is possible to cancel a regular travel booking in its entirety. Please contact the Transport Coordinator if you wish to do so. Please note Ad Hoc bookings cannot be cancelled.

***What should my child do if an extracurricular activity is cancelled on the day?***

If a sporting event or extracurricular activity is cancelled on the day, then parents should book a place for their child on the school coach via the Vectare website. The pupils must always have an advance booking when travelling on the school coach.

***If I cancel a trip, does the fare update?***

When cancelling a trip in accordance with the Terms & Conditions, the fare does not update in your account. However, when the charge is placed on the 'Extras Account' the amount charged will reflect the total number of trips that have not been marked as 'not travelling'.

## Rules for pupils

It is essential that you always act in such a way as to ensure your own safety and that of all other pupils using the coach. In particular please note the following:

- You must not run or push towards the coach as it approaches: this is very dangerous and greatly concerns the coach drivers. The potential for an accident involving a moving coach is obvious. You must not push each other, shout or generally misbehave.
- You should enter the coach slowly and carefully and sit down immediately.
- **You must remain in your seat at all times with your seat belt fastened.** Never walk up and down the aisle while the coach is moving.
- Do not kneel on your seat to talk to pupils behind you: you are only safe when you are sitting in your own seat facing forward with your seat belt fastened.
- You must not distract the driver by talking to him while he is driving
- You must follow any instructions the driver gives you, without question.
- Quiet talking is permitted, but you must not shout or make excessive noise on the coach.
- You must not eat or drink on the coach. It is unfair and unacceptable that the driver should have to tidy the coach at the end of the journey.
- No litter is to be left on the coach.
- Mobile phones must be used responsibly during a journey and the camera function should not be used. Headphones are required when listening to music or watching a programme and children should not be playing, watching or listening to material unless it is age appropriate.
- School bags, sports bags etc. should be placed on the floor (but not in the aisle or on the seats) to avoid damage to upholstery on the seats.

All these rules are designed with two aims in mind – your personal safety and the safety of every other boy and girl. If you are found to have misbehaved in any way you will be treated in the same manner as if you had broken any other school rule and may be excluded from using the service for a time. On the other hand, if you are concerned by anyone else's behaviour, it is essential that you tell someone about it as soon as you reach school, so that we can do whatever is necessary to ensure that the rules are followed by everyone – we need your help to ensure the safety of all coach users.

## JS Bus Club rules

Although JS Bus Club takes place after classes finish, it is a school activity. As such, the Junior School Values apply.



## Terms and Conditions

It is a condition of travelling on the school coaches that the following are accepted and adhered to:

1. All children must read and abide by the Rules for Pupils.
2. Transport on the school coach service must be arranged in advance.
3. Pupils will be charged for using the service regardless of whether they travel. Individual regular bookings may be cancelled without penalty prior to 9am on the day before the date of travel.
4. Seatbelts must be worn for the duration of the journey. Persistent offenders will be excluded from using the coach service.
5. Parents of Junior School pupils must notify the Transport Coordinator if their child is expected at JS Bus Club but is going to be absent.
6. The coaches are not supervised and ESMS cannot accept responsibility for children until they reach their classroom.
7. Coach drivers and ESMS cannot take responsibility for ensuring children get off the coach at the correct stop. It is the parents responsibility to ensure their child knows the coach they are travelling on and the stop they are alighting at.
8. ESMS and the coach company cannot take responsibility for any property left on the coaches. Many items will be returned to the Lost Property team in Home House – check there or contact AAA Coaches or Eve Coaches directly.
9. In the event of the cancellation of a service due to circumstances such as bad weather, a parent must be contactable to ensure appropriate alternative travel/collection arrangements are in place.
10. Pupils must arrive at their pick-up point at least 5 minutes before the scheduled departure time. Drivers cannot wait past the scheduled departure time at any bus stop.
11. Charges for the coach service are paid via Extras Accounts.

### **Adding your child/ren:**

Click on the 'My Account' section, then click 'Passengers'.

Click the new passenger icon  on the right and add your child's information.

Please enter their name as is appears on the school roll.

Repeat as necessary for subsequent children.

Pupil email and telephone fields are not mandatory; however, you may feel this would be beneficial to your child when using the coach service. This is primarily aimed at more senior levels.

### **Making a Booking:**

Bookings can be Regular (for the academic session) or Ad Hoc (occasional use).

To make a booking please click the coach route you require, the required stop and then click 'Book Now'. Alternatively, if you type your postcode in under the 'Find your nearest stop' banner on the top left-hand side and click 'Calculate', you will be able to choose your closest stop and click 'Book Now'.

Email confirmation will be sent to your email address once all the steps have been completed.

### **Regular**

Regular bookings can be amended or cancelled at any point. In addition, an individual journey can be removed from your booking as and when required.

To amend or cancel the whole booking please contact the Transport Coordinator.

To cancel individual journeys: go to My Account > Journey Calendar and click on the 'Mark as not travelling' option for any journeys you no longer require.

Parents can have multiple regular bookings for a child. This is required if your child uses a stop that is either AM or PM only and requires journeys to and from school.

Parents can use the Start Date option to set up bookings in advance.

For pupils attending P6/P7 camps and Carbisdale, the system automatically prevents you being charged for journeys during these weeks. **For other long periods of absence from school such as exam/study leave, please use the Journey Calendar to amend your child's booking accordingly.**

### **Ad Hoc**

Please note, it is not possible to cancel an Ad Hoc booking once it has been made.
